> I far as I currently know both Sport Calgary and the Acadia Community Association have yet to send correspondence to Alderman Carra verifying support one way or another. However, both groups are aware that Alderman Carra wishes to take a notice of motion to Council on March 18th. At this point in time we are still on schedule.

> As you may recall, our previous meetings did not give any certainty of a Licence of Occupation (LOC). The proposed Notice of Motion that Alderman Carra will be putting forward at Council is to direct Administration to investigate the feasibility of developing an indoor tennis facility within Acadia Athletic Park in partnership with Tennis Alberta. An LOC would only be signed between The City and Tennis Alberta if Tennis Alberta meets all of the obligations/timelines of the Partner Facility Development Process (enclosed). In the mean time, and as was agreed during out meetings with you, if Council approves the Notice of Motion, The City will provide Tennis Alberta with a letter of understanding or agreement that states The City is committed to working closely with Tennis Alberta through the Partner Facility Development Process for the development of an indoor tennis facility within Acadia Athletic Park.
